General Information

- **REGISTRATION**

The invited teams must fill out the registration form (Annex 1), send a copy via E-mail (lcaldero@eafit.edu.co) and another printed copy to the office of EAFIT Department of Sports, Carrera 49 # 7 South – 50, Building 3-105, fax (574) 2664284, with the signature and seal of the head of the university institution.

Registration is free.

- Application deadline: **July 22, 2011**. (After that date, the organization reserves the right to invite another institution). (Limited availability).

- Arrival of the delegations will be August 24 from 3:00 pm and the departure of the delegations will be on August 28, at 10:00 am).

Regulations

MALE AND FEMALE UNIVERSITY CATEGORY

The tournament will take place on the synthetic grass pitch at EAFIT University.

If a team does not have the minimum number of 7 (seven) players on the court at the moment of the game start, according to the schedule detailed in the program, timing will start to run and for every 3 minutes of lateness it will receive a goal against until completing the minimum number of players or reach the maximum number of goals. In such a case, it will lose the game by W.O. and will be expelled from the tournament.



All players must be wearing the same uniform (shirt and shorts), at the time of the game start, as well as the bracelet provided by the organization. Otherwise, the player or players will not be able to play the game.

Participants may be undergraduate and graduate students accredited and approved by the university they represent. All college players participating in this modality must belong to the university invited.

The maximum number of players registered for the category is 14 players (men or women) and a coach. This **one cannot** assume the status of a player. The invitation is for 15 people.

The matches will take place in the pitch at EAFIT University, under the parameters of the updated official WFDF regulations. The games will last 30 minutes with two timeouts, each one of 1 minute, or fifteen (15) goals. The game system will be all against all and the final between the first two.

The final match will last for two periods of 30 minutes each and a five-minute break.

The timeout may not be used within the last 5 minutes left for the end of the game. The scorekeeper will inform the time at which they play the last 5 minutes. (As shown in the official WFDF rules).

TIE-BREAK ITEMS

1. Game spirit.
2. Goal Difference.
3. Match between the 2 teams.
4. Greater number of goals scored.

The organizing committee reserves the right to expel a participating player or team committing any act of fraud, misconduct, unsportsmanlike behavior, psychoactive substance use, among others.



Awards

- At the university level, first and second place will be awarded as well as the team with the best Spirit of the Game and the Most Valuable Player in the male and female categories.
