CITIES FOR LIFE is the proposal Medellín wants to make to today's world. We have one goal: to bring together knowledge from around the world in a solidary, methodological and innovative way in order to solve complex challenges for the cities of today and tomorrow, and for their residents.

To accomplish this, Medellín will host the **CITIES FOR LIFE Global Meeting 2015** (<http://citiesfor.life>) on August 31st and September 1st.

The meeting will have two components; political and technical.

POLITICAL COMPONENT: This component, which will be the focus of the first day of the meeting, will allow mayors, and city leaders to open a debate regarding the role of cities in a globalized world and the main challenges they face today.

This component will also include a space for mayors, city officials, and city leaders to work together in a plenary session to build agreements on the way in which these challenges should be met. They will also be able to define goals to be achieved or guidelines for action as we create more effective cities for comprehensive human development.

The declaration created during this plenary session will be announced in a national and international press conference..

In the evening, the CITIES FOR LIFE platform will be officially launched. Participating cities will make a commitment to work together using this tool. In addition, the city to host the CITIES FOR LIFE Global Meeting 2016 will be elected.

TECHNICAL COMPONENT: This component, which will be addressed during part of the first day and all of the second day, will allow urban experts, city leaders, and other participants to develop a process for defining challenges, sharing experiences and concerns, and building agreements that will become a series of general technical recommendations for facing current and future challenges for cities.

We will offer six co-creation sessions corresponding to each of the meeting's central topics:

- Environment
- Government
- Mobility
- Security
- Social Development
- Urban Planning and Design

In addition, two sessions with special topics will be offered:

- Smart City and Citizen in light of Cities for Life
- Living Labs & open and disruptive Innovation Spaces

These sessions will include spaces for presenting and analyzing innovation success stories, sharing concerns and ideas for solutions, and creating agreements for future efforts.
